The Role:

Develop Material resource planning for materials commercialized in EMEA. Analyze the specificities of each assigned category of material to continuously improve the associated processes and reach the optimal balance between manufacturing, outsourcing and inventory.

Key responsibilities

- Translate sales forecast into material demand to develop manufacturing and outsourcing material planning for carbon and services supplied through Europe, by family/material, and by production line / vendor.
- Develop and maintain S&OP meetings and reports.
- Develop efficient internal communication with Operations, Sales, Finance and Product Management.
- Analyze material trends, identify risks and opportunities, and propose action plans
- Manage day to day operational logistics between plants, outside warehousing and external processing partners.
- Confirm availability of material for orders, quotations, tenders and projects.
- Interface with production plants, warehouses, vendors, to review and optimize capacity utilization.
- Analyze inventory levels, define targets and safety inventory levels, develop action plans on slow moving and blocked stocks.
- Interface with Warehouses to develop and improve management tools of warehousing, stock levels and inventory turnover.
- Review and recommend new tools for continuous improvement with demand and production planning.
- Work in close relationship with the other departments involved in order processing and material management to continuously improve processes and maximize the total value to our customers.
- Any other tasks related to Supply chain including participation to projects and SAP implementation and continuous improvement.
